- 3. Read **James 3:13-18**. In your experience, how often is the sin addressed in James 3:1-12 fueled by the "jealousy" and "selfishness" that James 3:13-18 zeroes in on? Why might remembering this connection be important?
- 4. Read **Esther 3:1-2**. What are some of the personal costs associated with not "bowing down" to our culture's blatantly "vile" heroes?
- 5. What are some of the common promises people make but choose to break when the promises become difficult to keep?
- 6. Read **1 Timothy 6:7-10**. Describe some of the ways "the love of money" can tempt you to forfeit your integrity?
