Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read James 1:16-17 and skim through Psalm 136. We can often fail to take note of God's gracious and faithful provision in our lives. What are some of the ways God has kindly provided you with "green pastures" and noticeably "restored your soul" over the past few years?
- 2. Read Romans 8:35-39. While obviously not exempt from life's pains and difficulties, how should the fact that we are God's loved and redeemed people radically change the way we view our painful trials?
- 3. Read 1 Peter 2:9-10. What are some of the various ways and contexts in which we can and should "proclaim his excellencies"?
- 4. Read 2 Corinthians 4:6-18. What would you say to a Christian who is prone to "despairing" and acting "crushed" when he is made to "walk through the valley of the shadow of death" or

surrounded by "enemies"?

5. Read Ephesians 3:20-21. What are some steps you can take to bolster a more "biblically optimistic" view of your Christian life without falling into the error of "the prosperity gospel"?
