- 2. Read **Proverbs 6:6-11**. Have you ever been tempted to use the call to "trust God" as an excuse for laziness? In what areas of your life has this happened?
- 3. Read **Acts 17:24-25** and **Deuteronomy 8:17-18**. As you go about your daily tasks, what are some of the practical ways you can remind yourself that you are in reality utterly dependent on God?
- 4. Read **Genesis 30:1-2**. How might the frequency of infertility in the Bible (e.g., Abraham & Sarah, Zechariah & Elizabeth, Elkanah & Hannah, Manoah & his wife, et al.) influence the thoughts and prayers of infertile Christian

couples today, as well as the thoughts and prayers of Christian parents who have been graciously granted children?

5. Read **Ephesians 6:4**. While all parents must profoundly depend on God for the growth, protection and spiritual development of their children, what are some of the substantial efforts involved in the correction and direction of our kids?
