These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. - 1. Read Luke 12:35-48. While there are some challenging details in these two parables (which we will eventually tackle when we get there in our study of the Gospel of Luke) how can the core concepts found in these instructive stories help motivate us in our consideration of today's topic?
- 2. Read 1 Corinthians 3:16-23. Keeping in mind that the repeated pronoun "you" in the original language is plural in v.16 (i.e., "you all"), how should this description of church life and the church leaders prompt value for and enthusiastic participation in the church?
- 3. Read Hebrews 10:23-25. What would you say to a Christian who tells you he likes to keep to himself and doesn't like small group settings?
- 4. Read Acts 2:42-47. What applicable aspects of this description of the first-century apostolic church challenge you as you consider your participation in the life of the church?
- Read 1 Peter 4:7-11. What is (or will be) your ministry post at Compass this fall? How can you make your service reflect this description in a greater way?
