Application Questions

- 2. Read **1 Peter 5:8-9**. How does this text and the direct identification of God's spiritual enemy and ours affect your thinking? What is the advantage of being "sober-minded" and "watchful" as opposed to ignorant and clueless regarding what lies behind some of our "suffering" (v.9)?
- 3. Read **2 Corinthians 12:7-10**. Based on this passage what practical counsel would you give Christians for whom God has chosen not to relieve their suffering?
- 4. Read **Luke 9:38**. In what way is the serious or chronic pain of someone we love an even more difficult challenge to our faith than when it is us that is suffering? How might we spiritually prepare and guard ourselves for times like these?
- 5. Read **Revelation 2:8-11**. Why are the resurrection of Christ and the coming kingdom so important to our endurance and strength?
