- 4. Read **Revelation 3:15-19**. What are some signs that a person has his loyalties split between the world and Christ? Why is this so hard to detect in one's own heart?
- 5. Read **Luke 9:57-62**. What are some of the specific concerns of the world you need to guard your heart against, so that your loyalty and love for Christ can remain your top priority?
