



1805 Joseph Smith Jr. born in Vermont 1816 Family moves to Palmyra, NY 1820 Father & Christ appear to say all religions corrupt Angel Moroni appear repeatedly to teach him 1826 Sued for using a seer stone to find buried treasure Moroni gives him gold plates buried in NY 1829 John the Baptist grants him the Aaronic priesthood Pt/Jms/Jn grant the Melchizedekian priesthood

Mormon History

Book of Mormon printed & church organized Mormons start to settle in Missouri 65 revelations printed in Book of Commandments 1833 Practice of polygamy privately practiced 1835 Bk of Com. revised/called Doctrine & Covenants 1839 19 Mormons killed in MO. group moves to Illinois New revelation allowing polygamy (slowly public) 1843 Joseph Smith jailed and killed in mob shootout

Mormon History

- Brigham Young leads LDS to future Salt Lake City 1851 Pearl of Great Price (added as Scripture in 1880) 1852 Polygamy publically taught 1862 Congress outlaws polygamy 1890 4th President tells LDS to stop practicing polygamy
- Mormons reach 1 million members 1950
- 1967 Book of Abraham "translated" added as Scripture 1978 Black men accepted into the priesthood


1. The Revised KJV Bible (by Joseph Smith – JST)

1. The Revised KJV Bible (by Joseph Smith – JST)

The Prophet's main work of revising, correcting, or translating the Bible was done during the three-year period from June 1830 to July 1833. During this time he and his scribes went through the Old and New



Testaments of the King James Version and produced nearly 500 pages of manuscript, containing thousands of variant readings and new passages

that clarify and enhance the message of the Bible. The eighth Article of Faith declares that "we believe the Bible to be the word of God as far as it is translated correctly. ..." The translation of the Bible




- 3. Doctrine and Covenants (1981 edition)

The words of our living prophets are also accepted as scripture.... In addition to these four books of scripture, the inspired words of our living prophets become scripture to us. Their words come to us through conferences, Church publications, and instructions to local priesthood leaders.

Teaching About God

- God was Once a Man
- God the Father has a Father
- He Progressed to Become a God by Obedience
- God is a Physical Being
- No Trinity. The Three are Three Gods
- Every Father God has a Heaven Wife (or Wives)
- They Produce Millions of Spirit Beings
- He Makes a World & Send Them to Inhabit Bodies

Teaching About People

- Human Beings Preexisted (eternal spirit)
- You Engaged in "Pre-Mortality" Deeds
- You will Engage in "Post-Mortality" Deeds
- Sin on Earth = Conscious Deeds (not Inherited)
- God Created Us to Become Gods Like Him
- Goal of Our Existence is to Attain Godhood
- "Eternal Life" = Godhood
- Dark Skin was a Punishment (Lamanites)

Teaching About Jesus Christ

- A Preexisting Spirit Like Us
- Jesus is the Father's Firstborn Spirit
- We are Literal Brothers & Sisters of Christ
- Jesus Divinity is Not Unique
- Lucifer is Also His & Our Brother
- Jesus = "Jehovah" of the OT (Father = Elohim)
- Jesus Incarnation was by Elohim's Sex Act

Teaching About Salvation

- Christ "Atoned" for Adam's Sin (not yours)
- Jesus Helped Us as Our Savior, Now Do Your Part
- Jesus' "Atonement" overcomes Physical Death
- Jesus gives Us General Salvation, not Individual
- People Must Progress Toward Increasing Perfection
- Baptism is Necessary for Salvation
- Hell for Satan & a Temporary place to hear Gospel
- 3 Levels of Heaven: Telestial / Terrestrial / Celestial

Teaching About The Priesthood

- Restored Aaronic / Levitical Priesthood (3 levels)
 (Once baptized...)
 - -- Deacons = 12 years old
 - -- Teachers = 14 years old
 - -- Priests = 16 years old
- Seen as a Preparatory Priesthood
- For the Temporal Needs of the Church
- Assist the Melchizedek Priests

Teaching About The Priesthood

Restored Melchizedekian Priesthood

Those holding the fullness of the Melchizedek Priesthood are kings and priests of the Most High God, holding the keys of power and blessings. In fact, that Priesthood is a perfect law of theocracy, and stands as God to give laws to the people, administering endless life to the sons and daughters of Adam

Teaching About The Priesthood

- Restored Melchizedekian Priesthood
- Mormonism claims to be a Theocratic Gov.'t for God
- Three Levels
 - -- Elder
 - -- Seventy
 - -- High Priest
- Need a Recommend to the Priesthood
 - -- 18+ yrs / on a Mission / Married in Temple

Teaching About Proxy Baptism

- AKA "Baptism for the Dead"
- Performed in the Mormon Temples
- Based on the Belief that Baptism Saves
- Offered for the Dead, Dead Then Choose to Accept it
- Done on Behalf of Those Who have Not Heard
- Point to 1 Corinthians 15:29 as Prooftext

"Burning in the Bosom"

• Doctrine & Covenants 9:8-9a

I say unto you, that you must study it out in your mind; then you must ask me if it be right, and if it is right I will cause that your bosom shall burn within you; therefore, you shall feel that it is right. But if it be not right you shall have no such feelings...

The word 'burning' in this scripture signifies a feeling of comfort and serenity. That is the witness many receive. That is way revelation works.
