- 1. Read **Genesis 3:16-19**. While these are certainly difficult words to read (especially because they still apply today), what help is derived in knowing that these things are precisely what God has ordered for the present age?
- 2. Read **1 Corinthians 15:51-55** and **Philippians 3:20-21**. Why should these verses occupy more of our thinking? How do we hold these in view without becoming unsympathetic about the real problems of the here and now?
- 3. Read **Proverbs 3:5-8**. How does trusting God "first and foremost" in the midst of our pain bring us "refreshment" even when our illnesses are not healed and the physical pain does not subside?
- 4. Read **Job 2:4-10** and **James 5:10-11**. What specific motivation can you derive from Job? What is at stake when you are not patient in your suffering?
