Acts 3:17 "And now, brothers, I know that you acted in ignorance, as did also your rulers. 18 But what God foretold by the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer, he thus fulfilled. 19 Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out, 20 that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus, 21 whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago.

- 2. Read **Romans 4:1-8**. Why is Christianity so unique as it relates to the way our sins are forgiven, and why is this such an important and necessary truth to showcase in our evangelism?

3. Read **Colossians 2:13-14** and **Psalm 103:10-12**. How can you learn to value your forgiveness more? How can this motivate you to speak up about the gospel with non-Christians more often?

4. Read **Hebrews 6:17-20** and **Titus 2:13**. How might you deepen your confidence and excitement in the promises of God concerning the Christian's eternal future?
